Juvenile Justice Online Pricing

For free agent use, Parent/Guadian of the Juvenile would pay a \$65.00 Fee to use this program. Thus, the police and/or School District uses JJO for free.

For unlimited users and the School District/Law Enforcement agency does not want parents/guardian to be responsible for the payment, there is a \$5000.00 license fee per year where the entity can place as many students as they would like throughout their school district or city. There is no limit on the amount of diversions an agency can do with a licensed contract. With an activated license, supervisors of the agent can have a running evaluation/list on their agents they supervise to make sure JJO is being used appropriately.

I note that many Munincipalities use their Drug Seizure Funds to pay this license due to the amount of Alcohol, Vaping and Drug Education JJO does in the diversion.
