Active Case Coordination by the MDT includes communicating with DCAC's Partner agencies to document and update client cases, initiating and coordinating case investigation and movement, and conducting case staffing meetings.

FORENSIC INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED

Forensic Interviewers use specialized training to conduct neutral, developmentally appropriate interviews with alleged child victims. These legally defensible interviews assist investigating partners and allow a child to make a clear disclosure of abuse.

CLIENT HOURS IN THERAPY

The Mental Health team provides trauma-focused, evidence-based therapy to children displaying symptoms of trauma and their caregivers. Delivering services to both children and their caregivers ensures that a child receives healing not just at DCAC, but at home as well.

FAMILY ADVOCACY CONTACT HOURS

Family Advocates remove barriers between families and recovery from trauma. This can take the form of practical assistance for families in crisis, helping caregivers navigate the criminal justice system, providing children's programming for siblings while one child and a caregiver attend a therapy session, and more.
