Our mission is to protect youth from being victimized by predators who leverage cyberspace as an international exploitation tactic. We accomplish this by serving as the bridge between the communities that we serve and those organizations who can take action. This includes establishing strategic partnerships with mental and behavioral health, academia, as well as the law enforcement and intelligence communities, in support of identifying key indicators that can lead to exploitation.

While our overall goal is to protect all youth, we have a special interest in those living in rural and marginalized areas who may be more vulnerable to predatory maneuvers.

-  We partner with national and international entities to obtain funding, sustain resources and tools, and to further collaboration and research, to expand our global outreach to the most vulnerable children.
